They are aware of the growth on the greens and are spraying the greens and the warmer temperatures will help.

Course improvements by the staff:

#7 The bunker on the left side of the green will be rebuilt, drainage and slope. They will have to close down the hole on a Monday to get two full days for the crew to reconstruct the sand trap.

#8 They want to make the front tee box bigger, and add the blue tees to the back of that box, and take out the blue tee box and use that extra dirt on the course for improvements.

#8 The extra dirt will be used to smooth the right side of the outside edge of the fairway.

#13 Make the front portion of the sand trap by the green open and visible to be seen from the fairway, and also redo the drainage in the trap.

#16 Add a sprinkler head and loam on the right side of the big tree just in front of the 150 yard marker, and extend the fairway to the right side of that tree.

Presidents Concerns:

Pin placements on some days are unrealistic. Difficult to putt with the greens as fast as they are.
