Randy Robertson made motion to approve Treasurer's Report and second by Art Keeton.

Vice President/Tournament Director Andy Gray report:

- Chapman tournament upcoming.
 - This will be pick your own partner.
 - Sign-up list will be available today in the clubhouse and online for this tournament.
 - Even though there was some confusion in the sign-up for the tournament, there will probably be options to sign up in the clubhouse and on line.
 - The member drive will be "clubhouse" to verify membership dues have been paid prior to entry.
- Jeff Wilson indicated that he will contact members who need to pay membership fee prior to the next tournament to make them eligible for entry.
- For all tournaments there will be a deadline to enter as follows:

- Saturday tournaments: Online (Wednesday), Clubhouse (Thursday) before the tournament.
- We want to recognize Susan Keeton for being willing to find volunteers to collect 50/50 money the day of tournaments for the year.
- Andy Gray will craft a letter/e-mail to all members explaining the process of signing up for tournaments.
- Members who miss the deadline can be placed on a waiting list to fill dropouts prior to the tournament.

Communication Director Art Keeton report:

- Sign-up sheets and online sign-up will only be available for one tournament at a time.
- Past members who are not active for 2026 will not receive e-mails after the end of March.
- WIX does not allow the deletion of a tournament after its completion. Therefore you will have to scroll through tournaments to get to the upcoming one.

Golf Pro Report, Jeff Wilson:

- The Holly Lake Ranch App and the web sight coordination has not yet been resolved. North Star has been contacted but has not made the necessary corrections yet, but should be made soon.
- The App should be available soon.
- Once everything has been rectfied, there will be a mass e-mail with tutorials.
- Outside play has already started, however it has not been at the pace we want, however once the Web and App problems are fixed, we feel the pace will improve considerably. The system, once available, is very user friendly.
- New carts are here and available for rental. There are no club covers or coolers on the carts which has resulted in a \$28,000 savings.
- The golf course is progressing well. Currently in process of Poa annua grass removal, dead tree removal and cartpath repairs are continuing.

New Business:

- Need to discuss the processes necessary to continue the Member/Guest tournament and changes need to make it the quality tournament it needs to be.
 - There has been some desention due to some problems that occurred last year. These issues will be addressed in a meeting with both the MGA and WGA leadership in the near future which Andy Gray will organize.
 - Keith Schmidt indicated the desire of the pro shop to maintain the Calcutta process, funds and distribution once the tournament has been completed.
